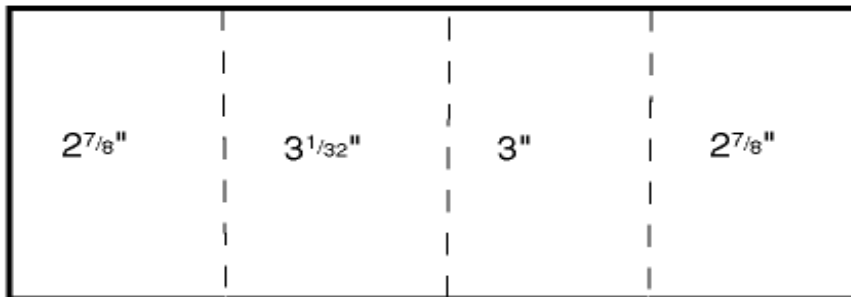
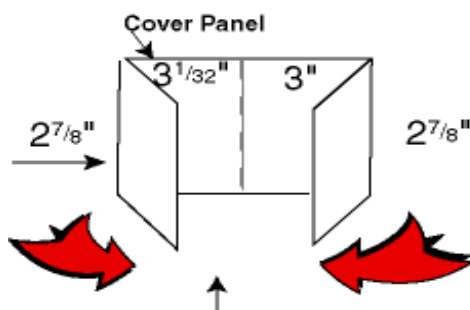


## Double Gate Fold Brochure

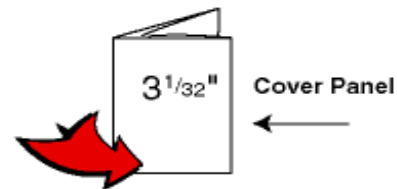
### Inside of a double gate fold brochure



Example: Set up document with 2 pages at 11.7812" x height.  
Pull in guides to separate panels. Do not create a new page for each panel. When the 2 outside panels fold in, there should be a minimum of  $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap down the middle. The cover panel should be  $\frac{1}{32}$ " larger than the back panel so a small "lip" hangs over.



When the two outside panels fold together, there should be at least  $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap down the middle. The two panels should not touch.



Fold the piece in half and the largest panel has a small "lip" that hangs over the back panel by  $\frac{1}{32}$ ".
